




Two **separate** streams, or one **single** stream? Are scholars in each field **aware** of the other? **Conducting research** in the other field?

## **Digital Sociology**

- ... is more **sociological** than informational
- ... is more **social** than technical
- ...struggles more with how to use and apply technology
  - Computational social science techniques less common
- ... is more about **power**, **ethics**, and **social justice**
- ...is somewhat more concerned with limitations, ability to access digital data, ethical issues in online spaces

## Awareness

- Digital sociology only loosely aware of (L)IS research
  - Multi- / interdisciplinary

Information scientists

- Cognate areas

Present and publish in interdisciplinary venues and conferences

aware, but perhaps not as digital sociology

– Terminologies differ
